no one would publish it, saying  
It was contrary to the Science of the  
day, but one Publisher said, "If we  
publish that M.S. all our Geologic-  
al works will go out of use".

One other M.S. was in the care of  
Capt. Petrie for several years at the

Victoria Institute for several years, but no Publisher would publish it for the same reason. Consequently the early chapters of Genesis are not to be received as they are given by Moses.

My writings substantiate the truth of the Mosaic account of Creation by the magnitude and superiority of both the flora and fauna that have and still are found in coal beds and other places in countries in all regions and zones of the earth all of great magnitude and the animal remains also testify that there was an evidence of the perfection of God's work which he pronounced "Very Good," meaning, Perfect.

But there have been also many evidences of the truth of Moses ac-

count of the Deluge and that it was universal.
