Your nomination has been indorsed by the Committee on Admission, but before proceeding to your election the Board of Managers would be glad to know your wishes.

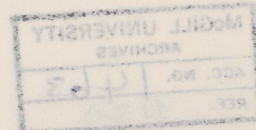
