Dear Papa,

I got the Bill of
Exchange, put to my credit at
the Bank without any trouble,
last Saturday.

Last night I was at the
meeting of the Geol. Socy. There
were three papers on the list, but

the first, & the discussions consequent
on it took up so much time that the
other two had to be postponed. It was
by Prestwiche, on the Norfolk Crag. & was
evidently a work of great labour, one
side of the room being completely
covered with ^{beautiful} sections illustrating it.

The discussion was carried on by
Messrs Dawkins, Seales Wood, Quin Joffins,
&c each seeming to disagree almost
entirely with all the rest. I did not
understand more than half of it, on
account of not knowing the names
of the beds, of which they spoke.
