



Dear Papa.

Mamma I hope
will be with you by this time.
We left Pala Hill yesterday
& as no-one came to claim
either the rent for Aug - or the
Keys we pocketed the latter, after
locking up & brought them to
Edinburgh. Mr Bell will send
them to Mr Cooper, the Trustee.
But the matter is now still
further complicated as Mr Tait
has managed a day or two
ago to get a discharge in the
bankruptcy. Mr Bell will reserve
payment till he finds out about
it.

I would like to have your opinion
about the *Lepidostrophi*. Are there not
two kinds? I think one of them must
have belonged to the *Lepidodendron*
(to which one I send is attached)
& the other to a tree something
like *Lepidodendron* but with the
markings much flattened out
laterally.  At least there
are the two most common
trees where the cones occur.

I found a very curious green-
grey, light coloured trap at one
place at Bt Island, which has
long bubble holes traversing it from
top to bottom. (Vertical as it originally
lay) They are now filled with Calc
spar. something like an amygdaloid

This would prove that at least
some of the traps was not injected
but flowed out, conformably, on the
surface from time to time.
