My dear Father,

I wrote a letter last week
to M^r Crow, but it seems he is not
in Liverpool as M^r Rudolf answered
the letter. He was kind enough to
make inquiries for me about the
different lines, & enclosed some of
their advertisements. It does not
seem that any of them have made any
particular reductions, so I think
I will do best by keeping to the Allan
line, & this is what M^r Rudolf him-
self also advises. The only advantage
that remains possible is in taking
a return ticket (good for 12 months)
which can be had for £30 instead
of £36 which two single tickets would

cost. This is certainly worth thinking
of. The Peruvian sails on the 25th
May, & the Polynesian on the 1st June

I have also written to Mr Leman
to ask ^{when} ~~whether~~ he is intending to sail
but I have not yet heard in answer.
It would be very nice if we could arrange
to go together.

I give a list of our days of exam-
ination on the other leaf. We (externes)
