Dearest Papa,

I am really surprised to find what base suspicions you have all entertained of B - I most it seemed to me about 6 months before I got a word from him, & as far B's people tell this day not a word has come from them so it is quite evident that they have even a worse opinion of him, than you have of me - We make daily pilgrimages to the V. B. & asked for letters till we were ashamed of the

constant reply, of "no letters received" I had been gone the  
length of threatening B with  
tears, of letters did not appear by  
when fortunately they did  
arrive I ascertained that final  
catastrophe.

Today is the first sweet-  
day we have had, I really stop  
we find it quite a pleasant  
change, at least I do.

On Saturday we set out  
to go to top of Mt Prospect  
but - having the path had  
a pretty rough time getting  
to the top without it - we  
still we did get there,  
though not at the point  
where the observatory is -  
I returned to the hotel  
quite revenues at about  
three o'clock - one night we  
staid out on the lake till

I fear my sketching  
will not be very brilliant  
but may give you idea of  
the place, we talked of  
stopping by the way at Part  
Kent where is a splendid

evening - taking train  
from Krauss's Pt. - but  
don't rely upon this decision  
we may get changed near  
mountains -
