My dear Father,

I have received the
tracing which you return, and
shall attend to the matters you
mention. Drysdale sends to-day
the two packages of tracts. There
are 300 of George's pamphlets, for
which Wilson charges \$16.⁰⁰ ^(net) and
explains its being so much by
the price of paper &c, being more
than he had anticipated. I
left 25 copies at Dawson's to
be sold at 25 ^{cts}, although the
price seems rather high when they
only cost 5 ^{cts} ³, unless there are
other expenses besides Wilson's bill.
The remainder are to be sent to
the College. I deposited D. N.'s

draw to my account; and have
drawn to-day \$66⁰⁰ of which
I enclose \$50⁰⁰ the remainder
being for the Printer, which I
shall pay to him as soon as
I learn from you that you do
not dispute the amount.
