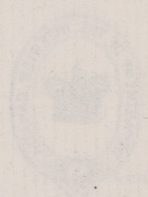

My dear father,

I hope now to be able to leave here on Saturday via Northern Pacific for Ottawa, but may possibly still have to wait till Monday. It takes an immense time arranging about these exhibition matters.
