My dear father,

Old Mr Ferrier  
Called on Friday to  
ask about prospects for  
Walter F. in connexion  
with Tarvey & Lobrotay, &  
I told him what I knew.  
He also spoke of the  
present difficulty in Quebec  
as to Medicine & Law,  
about which he appears to  
be concerned. Since then

I have spoken on the  
 same subject to Fister, who  
 as a Quebec Liberal should  
 have some weight with  
 the Mercier party, & I think  
 from what he said that  
 he may write to Quebec  
 people giving his views on  
 subject. He told me that  
 de Koven Trevelin had  
 at present considerable  
 influence at Quebec  
 & should ~~be~~ consulted &  
 interested in the matter.

& I said I had no doubt he  
 had been, as the subject had been  
 discussed by Law & Medical Faculties.  
 I see Mr Pagnulos' long letter in  
Gazette today. If I can advise it  
 would be that you should maintain  
 a very quiet & well tempered, &

firm position on the subject, as  
 nothing can be feared by raising  
 up ill feeling or putting it in a  
 distinctly Protestant v.s. Catholic  
 aspect—
