My dear Father,

I write this on Lewis R
not far below S. Lebarge, which we hope to
reach tomorrow. Am on the way out for Chilkoot,
Lynn Canal, in plenty of time to cross the
Mountains, & all well. The party of Miners
who take this are on the way out by same route,
but are travelling faster than we are with no stops
to make, & may reach Juneau, Alaska, in time
to catch a steamer in advance of the one we
may go south by. It will take us at least
two weeks to get to Coast from here, as
this up stream work is very slow.
