Kamloops 7 June 1889

My dear Father,

I arrived here  
safe & sound at 10 P.M.  
last night, & have since  
been at work getting things

Savings Bank pass books,  
all of which I hope you

 weekly Times which you have

 going first to Redstone &  
 then down the Columbia River  
 in a boat & up to Kootanie  
 Lake. I think I should be  
 able to get back here again  
 in about a month.
