what he says about the resemblance to  
Croatia Tertiary. This is merely a first  
idea which may not have much weight, but  
possibly the leaves might have some resemblance  
to those of Croatia also. Lyell describes  
the Tertiary there as Lower Miocene (I studied  
Elements) Plants are described by Weger.  
The title of his paper I find in R.S. Catalogue  
as attached; but I do not know if you  
have it.
