River, west of the Rocky Mountains & in
the far northern part of B.C. The question
of their age lies between Miocene of B.C.
& Pliocene. McC's description of their
mode of occurrence in relation to present
valleys seems rather in favour of a
Miocene date, but the appearance of the
rocks themselves causes him to be inclined
to suppose them Pliocene
