My dear Father,

I arrived here last  
night, on a rocket at 3 o'clock  
this morning & here the day  
(Sunday) to wait before getting  
the train at 8 tomorrow morning  
for Edmonton. The first two  
days of railway journey were  
quite cool, but yesterday was  
pretty warm & dry & today  
is the same. Very reasonable  
weather & just what is wanted to  
bring on the crops. Calgary is



very much changed since  
you were here, with some  
really handsome stone buildings  
& a considerable population.

I find a number of people here  
whom I know, or rather some of  
whom I remember while others  
know me, but I am  
only looting today, with no  
particular occupation, & this  
note is intended only to report  
progress.
