company when I return,
though if need be I should
like you to be hospitable. I
should like however to have
my Margaret all to my-
self. I send a parcel by the
stage with two hampers for
the girls. I send Sugar &c
by Currier's vessel, now here.
I wish the day to pass quickly till I
see you but I know they will pass slow
