Dear Mamma,

I got your  
kind, long letter last night  
together with ones from William  
and Anna, and proceed  
to comply with your  
request to answer imme-  
diately.

I do not think it at all  
necessary for any one to come  
down here to take me up, but  
if any of you would like  
the trip would of course  
be very glad to see you

but don't on any account  
come down at inconvenience  
to yourselves, as I am  
quite able to come up  
myself, when the time comes  
and by the by when do  
you think I ought, I  
suppose I had better stay  
to the end of this month  
at any rate, the hotel will  
likely close about the 5<sup>th</sup>  
of next month had I  
better stay till then?

I have spent three or four  
dollars of the ten you  
left me, and if I make

the trip up the Saguenay  
which I should like to do.  
I will want some more  
money before for the expenses  
home &c. I have not enquired  
what the Saguenay trip  
would cost but suppose  
with meals berth &c about  
two and a half dollars.

Please write soon and  
tell me about all these things.

We had another concert  
here last Friday which was  
a great success realising 45  
dollars & enclose a programme.

Mr & Mrs Taylor, Reid, and

Herbert are here now, but  
are going home this afternoon  
& Mrs I said she would  
call on you, on her return.

The dinner gong has sounded  
some time ago, so I cannot  
write more this time, ~~but~~  
so please excuse this scrawl.

Give my best love to all at  
home, and tell Anna, and  
William that I will try to  
write them ~~that~~ next time  
which wout be long.
