My dear Mrs Danvers

We are leaving
for home this morning. I
am thoroughly tired and
not well, so we have con-
sulted that was our
last course. I regret very
much not seeing any of you
again at present, but
hope to do so before very
long. I hope you will
let me know when your
husband is to come to
Fairport, that we may

be ready for him. All
we did yesterday was to
go to Murrumbidgee, and dine
with a friend in that
neighbourhood. I have done
no shopping. My friends
where I was last evening
recommended St Paul's Church,
I said, but not Cheapside,
as moderate in price.
