for Easter & spent a day
with us. & she wants you
also & we thought if it
could be arranged - it
might be convenient for
you to take us on your
way - however you will
see & must let me know.
We should like to leave
St. William this time

as well if possible. I
expect my husband will
be at Breunig house if
all's well I will doubt-
-less see you there - but
I shall be unable
to leave home most
probably. —
