At a meeting of the Church of England Clergy of the City and District of Montreal, his Lordship the Bishop presiding, the following resolution was adopted.

Whereas it has pleased Almighty God to call to his rest, full of years and honours, Sir William Dawson, LL.D., F.R.S., F.G.S., C.M.G., one of Canada's most distinguished and gifted sons, We, the Bishop and Clergy of the Church of England, in Montreal, desire to place on record a marked expression of our high appreciation of his eminent ability and learning, as also of his consistent and devoted Christian life and character.

And, in recognising the incalculable services which he rendered to the cause of education in this Country, as Principal of McGill University, and in other positions, We would especially record our deep sense of gratitude and indebtedness to him for using as he did his masterly talents and scientific research in defence of the Christian verities and the Inspired Word of God, whereby his name has become known and honoured throughout all Christendom.

Be it resolved,

That, the Bishop and Clergy do attend the funeral in a body, and that

Lady Dawson and family be assured  
of our deep sympathy with them in their  
bereavement, and of our prayers that  
the God of all consolation may comfort  
and sustain them as He only can.
