My dear Anna

Thanks for your last
loy letter. I have been far too cross
lately to write "jossipy letters" & have
not yet returned to that state of
equanimity which would render it
possible. It is too sarcastic of you
at home after helping night & main
to forge the chains to write down wildly
about letting people choose for themselves &c
I have been in a chronic state of misery
for the last ten days about losing
the B.C. appointment, & have hardly

yet begun to be reconciled to the
Commission appointment, or to
find pleasure in that, or anything
else.

My lectures are getting on as well
as possible under the circumstances
next Monday's will be the tenth &
then they will be half over. I have
not yet given over writing them out,
but on the contrary always write
them out twice. This occupies a good
deal of time.

The Carrs seem to be very pleasant
hospitable people, & very frank with
the exception of Hamilton who is rather
shy. The amusement consisted
of looking at photographs, reading,

Talking, eating, & going to Church.

Naime MacLmont is very pleasant
& I have been asked there in a quiet
way several times, but have only been
able to go twice. N.B. what is the
old Miss MacLmonts' first name. The
notes I received were signed Anna but I
was not knowing who that may be
is rather awkward in answering.

Mrs Watterspoon has been more or less
unwell so I have not been there. Lina
has been at M.L. both times I have
gone. I think she must be staying
there. Frank as you remark called
on me but I was not in. He
comes to my lectures. Sits on a
back bench & slopes rapidly at
the close. So I have not had the
pleasure of much acquaintance.
