has been remarkably  
fine, both quiet & mild,  
very little sea-sickness

on board a ship not  
 crowded. I write you  
 a line for waiting  
 from Inverness to catch  
 the outgoing Cunard  
 steamer on Saturday.

 particular news to communicate.

I hope that you have not  
 suffered from the very heavy  
 work you had in helping  
 Mother & Father off &  
 that you have had good news



of them from the South,  
 -I have written a note  
 to mother to go back  
 at some time with this.  
 After Father gets somewhat  
 stranger I feel that there  
 may be danger of his  
 finding it insupportably  
 tedious in the South,  
 & as he works at  
 whatever material he  
 has taken, will begin to
