Dear Mother,

There are very few people down here as yet but we expect a big crowd to arrive on both Wednesday and Saturday of this week. Father and the others come on Wednesday I think. The weather still keeps fine and wet and also pretty cold but I suppose we will get fine weather in time. Aunt Florence came down with the kids last Wednesday. I suppose you are getting bad weather also for everybody seems to be getting lots of it this year. I have just finished reading Red Rock by a fellow called Page it is a pretty good story but rather long for there were 582 pages. I am now starting The Light of Scattery but I have not got into the story as yet. Thanks very much for the photo of Chester etc. We have got the baseball diamond fixed up much better this year for we spent about \$9.00 in improvements
