Dearest B -

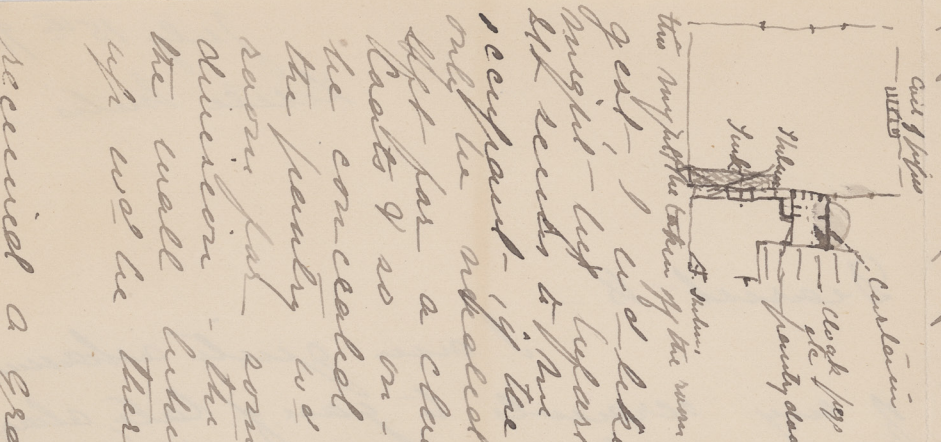
I am quite ashamed
