Dear Bernard,

Anna's letter of
the 12th reached me
on Saturday, and I
am glad that she
is able to record even
some little improvement
in Eric's health, and
hope it may continue
and that you may
be guided to the best
locality and the
best treatment. I quite
feel that the medical
physicians rather blunder

our eyes in the matter,
measuring I hope, but
I pray God that there
may still be time to
kick out a snuff
bunch. In the mean
time all seems going
on ^{well} here, though I fear
Grandma and I deplore
institutions for children.
Her nice letters to
the children are how-
ever a power for good.
We shall of course be
glad to see you here;
but hope you will take
all time necessary to
deal debilitated with

Eric's case, as that is
at the moment the
main case.

When I wrote last
week I was under the
impression that you might
be coming on almost
at once to Montreal;
but the little matters
in my memo have in
the mean time nearly
settled themselves. Fleet
has been here, and

Merley reports an offer
of a mortgage for \$1000
at 6 per cent. I have said
to him that I do not
care to break up the
case till I hear from
you. If however you think
well of this you might

Telegraph to me, and
I shall send him an
order in my own age
till you can come and
take up the deposit
receipt, which however
is earning 3% per cent in
any case.
