material from which the Buckets
are made.

while Buck no 1 is made from
marl and blue clay - proportion of
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ of clay to 1 of marl -

white Buck no 2 is made from
the yellow clay - marl 2 proportion
of - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ of clay - to 1 of marl - which
gives a different shade.

The red Buck are made from the
yellow clay - marked no 2

The yellow clay is procured at our
Buck yard, while the small
and blue clay have to be drawn
quite a distance—

I have manufactured
as many as a million of Buck a
year and employ some 15 fifteen
men.

The average price of the
Buck is eight 8⁰⁰ dollars a thousand.

Trusting you will find this
satisfactory I am
