Dear Sir,

In reply to your
 telegram of the 27th inst.
 I beg to say that though I
 am not anxious to ^{dispose} sell of
 my lot on St Catherine St,
 as I offered it for ~~60~~ ^{sixty} cents
 a foot Mr Major may have
 it at that price, if the
 terms to be arranged on
 my return to town, about
^{2 weeks hence}
 I presume that Mr Major
 employed you to negotiate
 the purchase, and therefore
 strictly speaking you should
 look to him for your commission

rather than to me who
did not solicit your
services in the matter.
If, however, the sale is
bona fide and the
terms satisfactory I have
no objection to paying you
a commission of ^{one and a half} per
cent when the deed
is passed. I have
been absent for a few
days & would have
written sooner.
