

Pictou 26th Sept 1872

My dear Sir

I have just rec^d a letter from your father in which he says Prentice is anxious to get area 108 on the Plan embraced in the offer of areas to him it being however, together with Area 113, at present excluded by the schedule furnished him at Pictou. Your father recommends 108 to be given up or at all events the portion of it containing the red hematite extending out of the Hudson area. Will you please order some work to be done on it trying to find the limonite which is said to appear on it in boulders and ask Mr. Fraser to keep a separate $\frac{1}{4}$ of all exploration expenses incurred on this area. It would also be very advisable to prospect for the limonite on Area 46 where Fraser knows that the ore has been reserved by the Grants.

It would be important to find the limonite on either or both of these areas and in some measure make up for the difficulties existing at Husw Saddlers and be a solatium for these difficulties in our dealing with Prentice. We have no doubt the parties residing on the reserved properties would willingly assist in prospecting on them. You will observe that on 108 the first Right Expires June 4th 1872 and if the boundaries of that first area ^{to} be taken then could be ascertained now it would be advantageous. You might also try to find how far the hematite extends out of Hudsons area into 108. but the greatest importance would attach to a discovery of the limonite on 108 or on the reserved portions of 46. & if discovered "in situ" no expense should be spared to prepare it for examination by Prentice's Engineers.
