Sir,

Having observed in the Parliamentary debate of April 10. that it is the intention of the Government to collect & print information on the North-West Territories, I have thought it possible that they might wish copies of that part of the report of last Summers work now in the press, & dealing with deposits of lignite coal in the vicinity of the Boundary Line.

The subject appears to be important economically, especially when considered with reference to the explorations of the Geological Survey on the Saskatchewan & the use made of similar fuels on the line of the Union Pacific R.R.
