I have been to Comp Shenikden Lat 42° 45' 11" Long 102° 31' 57", was at this point May 29 to June 3d and observed them passing North in immense numbers.

If you have any observers in B America East of the mountains perhaps these insects can be traced to their habitat I will try and ascertain if they stop in Dakota, I am
