My dear Sir,

I should wish to have for the Peau River Expedition a small party independent in regard to transport &c. The supplies might for or together to some point of distribution, or be separately apportioned from the fur as may be thought best.

The constitution of my party I should propose to be as follows. —

1. Good Packer
1. Packers assistant & Cook (Lillooet)
4. Riding animals, saddles &c.
4. Pack animals, rigging &c. (for Camp & baggage)
1. Set Kibbeten utensils, dishes &c. for 5 persons
1. Light tent for men.
1. Cargo cover
8. Pairs Blankets

Pack animals for provisions, probably at least six.
Provisions for party of 5 persons, on same scale as adopted for C.P.R.'s party.

It would be convenient if the party & articles mentioned could be got together at Kamloops or other outfitting

point, leaving the settlement for them to be made
afterwards as you may wish.

Additional tents & other articles not enumerated I would
get in Victoria & take up with me.

I propose to leave here next Wednesday or Thursday,
trusting to catch one of the Portland Steamers, which
sail about twice a week but at irregular dates
