



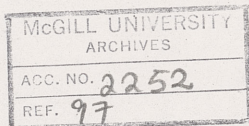

he will have more time at



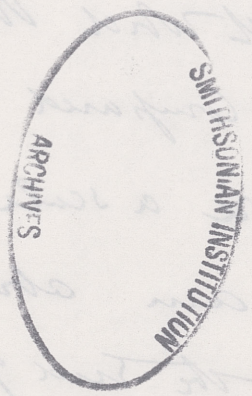
