Dear George,

On again looking  
at your Calcareous fossils  
from Department Bay St  
Auguste Id. I come  
to the conclusion that  
the finest cellular masses  
are Wallipores; but I  
have not means at  
hand, without making  
many slices, & refer  
them to any particular  
genus of that group.

The coarser masses  
may be another  
species of ~~the~~ the  
same group; but  
are possibly fine corals  
allied to the *Palaeo-*  
*Sive Solenospira*, *Beud.*  
There there are fragments  
of calcareous *Byzosa*,  
of *Crinoids* and  
of shells with *prismatic*

Structure. There is how-  
ever nothing sufficiently  
characteristic to give  
good evidence of  
eye. I shall  
put up the specimens  
and return them  
whenever I can  
get time.
