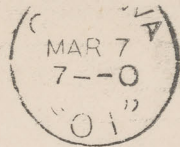

I, George Mercer Dawson of the City of Ottawa in the County of Carleton and Province of Ontario, Esquire, hereby declare this to be my Last Will and Testament.

I give and bequeath to my sister Anna Lois Harrington of the City of Montreal, the sum of One thousand dollars for her sole and separate use and absolutely.

I give and bequeath to my brother William Bell Dawson of the City of Ottawa, the sum of One thousand dollars for his sole and only use absolutely.

I give and bequeath to Gloranna Dawson wife of Dr. Rankin Dawson the sum of One thousand dollars to be held by her in trust for her daughter, Margaret Rita Dawson until she shall attain the age of twenty-one years.

I devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal unto my trustees and executors hereinafter named, their executors and administrators, upon the trusts following:-

I direct my said trustees and executors or the survivor of them his or her executors or administrators to convert all my estate ~~into~~ money (with the exception hereinafter named) into money as soon as may be after my death, and after the payment thereof of all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses and the legacies in this my will contained, to divide the ~~residue~~ residue into four equal shares or portions and to distribute and pay such shares or portions, as follows; one of such shares or portions to my said sister Anna Lois Harrington for her sole and separate use absolutely, a second of such shares or portions to my sister Eva Atkin of Liverpool for her sole and separate use absolutely, and a third of such shares or portions to my brother William Bell Dawson for his sole and only use absolutely, and as regards the fourth share or portion I direct my said trustees and the survivor of them to invest the same in and upon such stocks, funds, mortgages or securities or upon any real property securities as to them may seem best and to vary such investments from time to time for any of a like nature or otherwise, as they may deem advisable; and to pay the annual income thereof to my
