REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, MARRIAGES AND DEATHS.

- “Under the provisions of the Agriculture Statistics and Health Act, 1883, all births, marriages and deaths must be registered with the Clerk of the Municipality in which they occur.
- “Births must be registered by the father or mother, or in case of their death, or inability, then by any guardian, the occupier of the house in which the child was born, or by the nurse, within thirty days from the birth.
- “Clergymen must register marriages at which they officiate within thirty days thereafter.
- “Deaths must be registered by the occupier of the house in which they occur, or by some person present at the death, before the body is buried.
- “Clergymen performing service over any body, without receiving a certificate that the death has been registered, must register it within one month.
- “Medical practitioners must register the cause of their patients' death within one month.
- “Refusal or neglect to make these reports within the specified time will subject defaulters to a penalty of twenty-five dollars and costs.
- “Slips on which to enter particulars for registration can be obtained free, from all municipal clerks and postmasters. After being filled up they will be conveyed to municipal clerks free of postage.”
