You come out here for the summer, and if it is possible for me to send you the money to do so, will you do it?

I have an engine that I attach to a row boat which makes a motor boat of it, and will push an ordinary 16 foot boat 8 miles an hour.

We will go to Priest Lake and have a good time - Now my dear boy write me a long letter and tell me all about yourself
