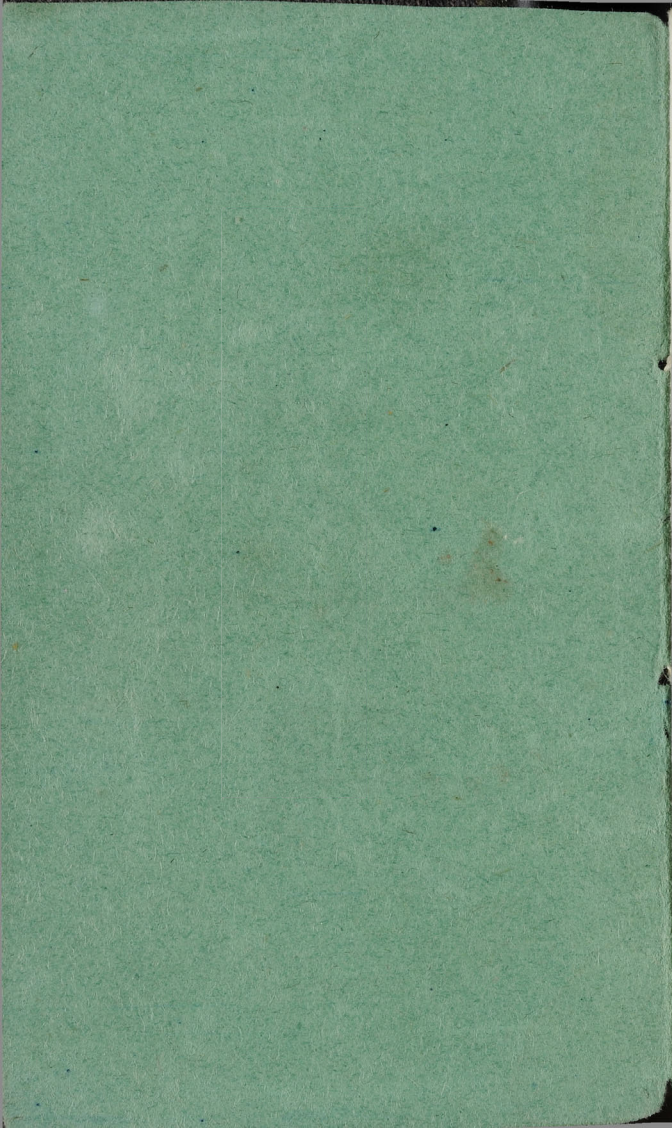

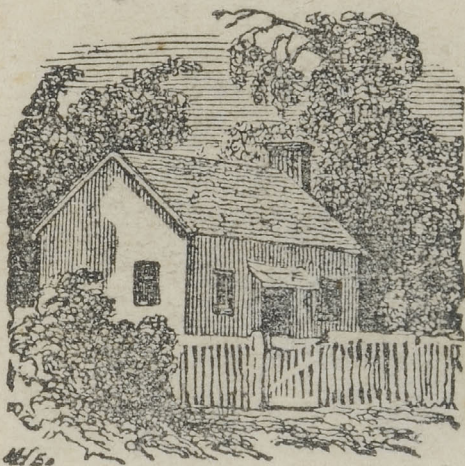
Was Aunt Agatha,
