To THE SHAREHOLDERS:—

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the eighty-second Annual Report of the affairs of the Bank and the result of its operations for the year ending December 31st, 1928.

The net profits for the year were \$344,901.64, and the balance brought forward from last year's profits account was \$139,578.79, making a total of \$484,480.43. From this amount have been paid four quarterly dividends to our shareholders; \$1,400.00 has been contributed to various charitable and philanthropic Funds— independently of the sum of \$10,200.00, interest on the Charity Donation Fund, distributed as usual, and \$200,000.00 has been added to the Reserve Fund, leaving a balance at the credit of Profits account of \$43,749.88 to be carried forward to next year.

As usual a frequent and thorough inspection of the books and assets of the Bank has been made during the year.

The report of the Auditors and the Balance Sheet are herewith submitted.
