III. A partial eclipse of the Moon, August 14th, visible. Moon enters shadow, 14th. 9.39 p.m.; middle of eclipse, 14th, 10.41 p.m. Moon leaves shadow, 14th, 10.43 p.m. Eastern Standard time, magnitude of eclipse, 0.29 (Moon's diameter, 1.0).

IV. A total eclipse of the Sun, August 30th, visible as a partial eclipse at Toronto. The eclipse begins on 30th, 5.17.6 a.m. The sun being in the horizon, eclipse ends 30th, 7.34.3 a.m. At Montreal, eclipse begins 30th, 5.40.4 a.m. Eclipse ends 30th, 7.39.8 a.m. Magnitude of eclipse 0.8 (Sun's diameter, 1.0).

MORNING AND EVENING STARS

VENUS will be an Evening Star to April 27th, afterwards a Morning Star.

MARS will be a Morning Star to May 8th, afterwards an Evening Star.

JUPITER will be an Evening Star to May 4th, a Morning Star to November 24th, then Evening Star.

SATURN will be an Evening Star to February 12th, a Morning Star to August 23rd, then Evening Star.

MERCURY will be at its greatest W. Elongation, January 22nd, May 21st, and September 15th, and at its greatest E. Elongation, April 4th, August 2nd and November 26th.


