

The ZODIAC

An Outline of Its History

THE Zodiac is an imaginary band in the heavens, in which lie the paths of the sun, moon and principal planets. It is about 18° wide and is divided into twelve parts called "Signs," of 30° each, thus making a complete circle of 360°. The ancients named each of these signs from their conception of the constellation of stars in it.

This twelvefold division of the Zodiac is responsible for our calendar year of twelve months and was probably suggested by the twelve full moons which appear in different parts of the Zodiac during the year.

GEMINI—

The Twins

This name celebrates the legend of twins who were reared by a wolf and later built Rome.

LEO—*The Lion*

The lion was the ancients' symbol of heat and is here used to indicate the culmination of the Sun's fire.

LIBRA—

The Balance

This name is of comparatively modern origin and represents the equality of day and night at this season.

SAGITTARIUS—

The Archer

This sign was apparently named after the Babylonian god of war, a centaur (horse-man) archer.

AQUARIUS—

The Water-man

This sign is derived from the heavy rains and the overflow of the Nile which occurred at this season.

ARIES—*The Ram*

This name is probably derived from the first Babylonian month, Nisan, when sacrifices of rams were made.



PISCES—*The Fishes*

The fishes, ancient symbol of life after death, here mean the resumption of labor after the heavy rains.

TAURUS—

The Bull

This name is the result of the ancients' conception of the sun as a bull, plowing his way among the stars.

CANCER—

The Crab

Here the retreat of the sun from its farthest northern point is associated with the backward motion of the crab.

VIRGO—

The Virgin

This sign commemorates the Babylonian and Assyrian myth of Ishtar, the goddess of fertility.

SCORPIO—

The Scorpion

This name associates the symbol of darkness with the sun's decline in power after the autumnal equinox.


CAPRICORNUS—*The Goat*

This name is probably taken from the old legend of the goat that nursed the young gods of the sun.

Many primitive peoples had this same idea of dividing the sky into sections and naming each section. The Chinese had a Zodiacal system of inestimable age, the Aztecs, that wonderful civilization of South America, had their Zodiac, the ancient Hindus and Arabs had a Zodiac based on the phases of the moon.

But the Zodiac as we understand it today was probably originated in Mesopotamia and was more fully developed by the Chaldeans who built Babylon. Assyrian cylinders over four thousand years old showing the Signs of the Zodiac, have been found, but the Zodiac is probably older than that.

The astrologers of the ancient civilization passed along to their successors their names for the Signs of the Zodiac. Some of these were retained and others discarded so that the names we use for the Signs of the Zodiac today have no common origin. While all are in the Roman language, they were devised by Assyrians, Chaldeans, Greeks and Romans. The following generally accepted version of their origin is most interesting.

FLAG ETIQUETTE

1. Do not permit disrespect to be shown to the Flag.
2. The Flag should never be allowed to touch the ground.
3. The Flag should be displayed from sunrise to sunset only.
4. When carried with other flags, the Flag should be in front or on the right.
5. The Flag should always fly at the top of the staff except when at half-mast for mourning.
6. When the Flag is displayed against a wall, either vertically or horizontally, the field of stars should be up and to one's left when facing the Flag.
7. When displayed across a street, the Flag should be suspended vertically, with the field of stars to the NORTH or the EAST.
8. Never use the Flag for drapery of any kind, on an automobile, on a speaker's table, etc. Use bunting instead.
9. Do not put lettering of any kind on the Flag.
10. Do not use the Flag in any form of advertising.

Wet a woolen cloth with linseed oil and rub over the oven surfaces until the rust disappears. Then rub with a dry, clean cloth. Then turn on the oven burners until thoroughly dried out. Do this monthly to make the range last longer and bake better.

FLOOR POLISH

Melted candle grease and turpentine, in equal parts, makes a fine floor polish.

BEATING WHITES OF EGGS

A little salt added to the whites of eggs in beating will make them fluff quickly.

FIRST AID SUGGESTIONS


FAINING—Keep patient in comfortable reclining position. Give him plenty of air and loosen clothing for free breathing. If face is flushed, raise feet slightly higher than head. If face is pale, raise head slightly higher than feet. Let him smell ammonia or smelling salts. Do NOT try to give an unconscious person a stimulant. Keep him warm and let him rest when made comfortable. If condition continues, summon a doctor at once.

POISONING—Dilute the poison by giving milk, soda water, tea, flour water or any harmless liquid to fill the stomach. Send for a doctor at

once. Cause the patient to vomit by giving him mustard in warm water and by tickling the back of the throat. After the vomiting, give him warm water.

SCALDS AND BURNS—For scalds and heat burns, apply DeWITT'S Carbolated Witch Hazel Salve generously and bind with clean cloth.




Diagram of location of kidneys
