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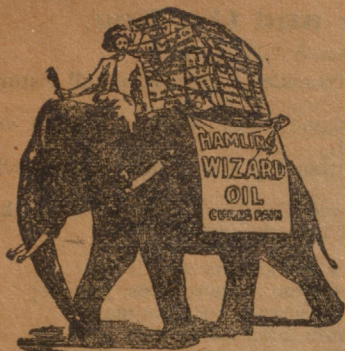

In a few hours high fever appears, with rapid pulse, coated tongue, thirst, and in most cases, by acid sweats. The parts most generally affected are the ankles, knees, wrists, and elbows, the joints becoming swollen, hot, red, and painful. As the symptoms decline in one part, they appear in others.

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CRIPPLE FOR TWO YEARS PERMANENTLY CURED.

NEURALGIA

This painful affection, formerly known as "Tic Doloieux," attacks principally women and those with debilitated nerves. The pain arising from its existence is most severe, and its continuation for any extended period leads to a general breaking down of the nervous system. So acute is the sympathy existing between the nerves of the body, that what affects one in time affects all, leading to serious results. The disease robs night of the opportunity for needed rest and fills the day with agony. Many have had recourse to the use of morphine, principally by means of a hypodermic syringe, to relieve their sufferings and in many instances the enslaving opium habit has been the outcome. **Beware of Morphine.**

SYMPTOMS—Neuralgia generally affects the face, neck, chest, feet or abdominal organs. It often occurs after exposure to cold drafts, or sudden changes in temperature, and may be sudden and severe or appear gradually with uneasy, tingling sensations. The pain comes at close intervals and is usually shooting or darting in character. The affected parts may be swollen and inflamed at times and very tender and sensitive to the touch. It is often mistaken for toothache when located in the face, and when in the abdomen, stomach, or heart, is on the order of severe cramps and muscular convulsions.

TREATMENT—Hot applications afford temporary relief. In facial neuralgia always ascertain if the teeth are decayed; if so, have them attended to immediately. Decaying teeth often superinduce neuralgia. The bowels should be acted upon gently by using some mild cathartic, (**Hamlin's Blood and Liver Pills** are the best we know of for this purpose) and the seat of pain bathed with clear **Wizard Oil** until relief is obtained; a teaspoonful of **Wizard Oil** should be taken internally in half a teacupful of milk or water twice a day, and this dose and the external application repeated until the cure is effected. Usually from one to three doses taken internally, together with as many external applications of **Wizard Oil**, freely made will effect an entire cure, but in stubborn cases it must be persevered in, until the desired relief is obtained.

Whooping Cough

CHOLERA MORBUS -----AND COLIC-----

REMARKS—The first generally arises from irritation caused by eating unripe fruit, stale vegetables, etc. The latter much from the same cause, although it may be brought about by cold or gases arising from improper digestion.



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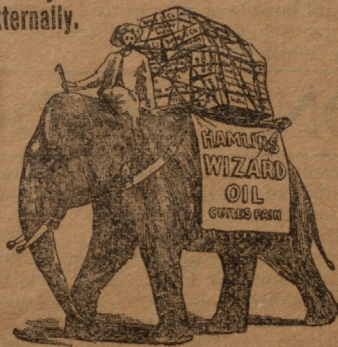
