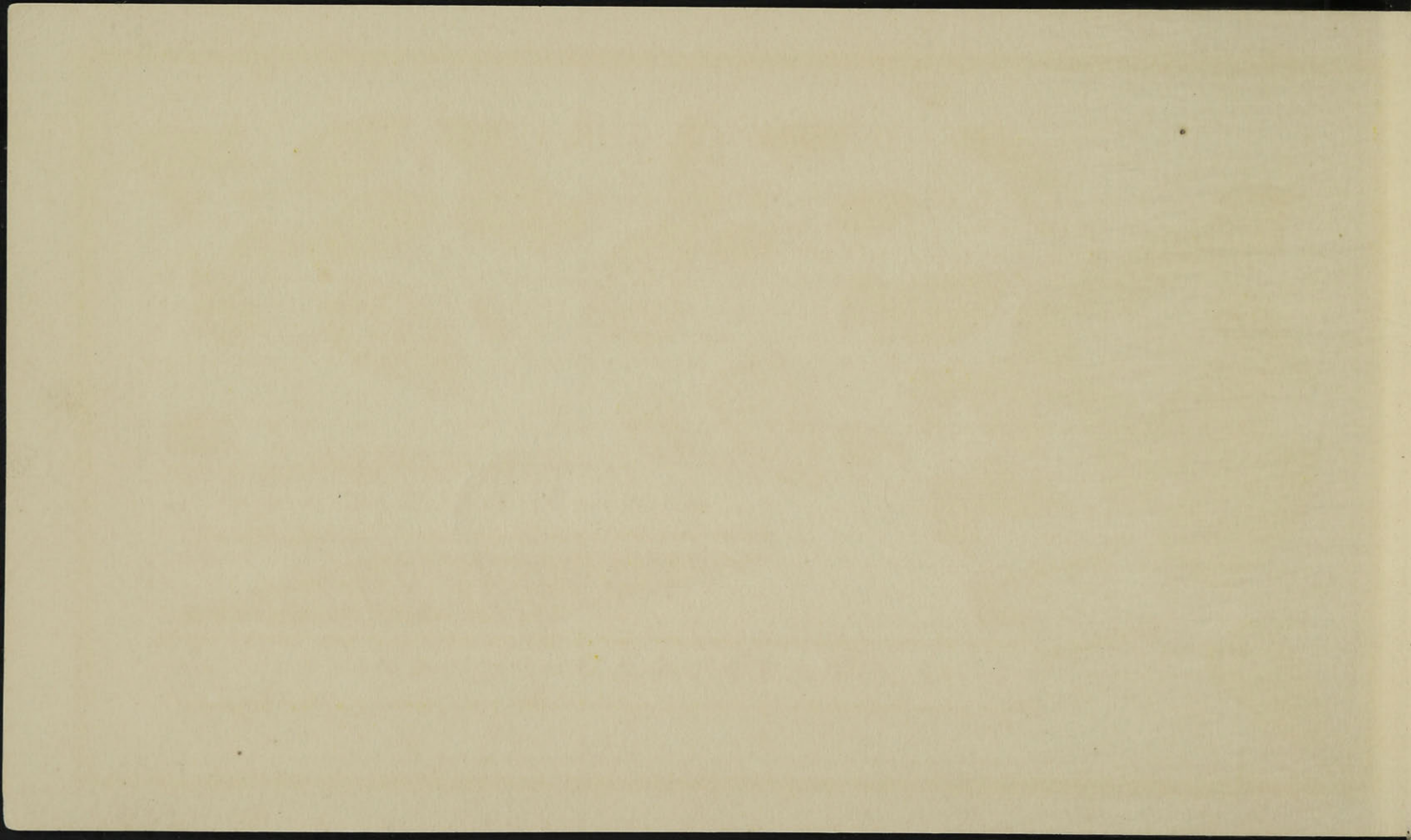

## THE HISTORY OF THE UNIT.

THE origin of No. 7 "Overseas" Stationary Hospital was the desire of the medical faculty of the University of Dalhousie to serve their country in the war. Early in September 1914 an offer was made to provide the medical staff of a Casualty Clearing Station, and the offer was renewed in the spring of 1915. But the Government was not then in a position to accept these offers. In the meantime the offers of the Universities of M'Gill and of Toronto, of the staff of General Hospitals, and that of Queen's, to staff a Stationary Hospital, were accepted. It was felt that the University of Dalhousie, possessing the only medical faculty in the Maritime Provinces, should also be represented on the Canadian Expeditionary Force.

The members of the faculty who took the most active steps in renewing the offer were Major GEORGE M. CAMPBELL, A.M.C., Major E. V. HOGAN, 1st C.A., and Captains L. M. MURRAY, M. A. MACAULAY, F. V. WOODBURY, and J. R. CORSTON, of the C.A.M.C., who were already on active service. Their efforts met with the warmest encouragement from the President and Governors of the University. A deputation representing the Governors and the Faculty was sent to Ottawa, and, on 13th August 1915, renewed the offer of the University, and extended it to the staff necessary for a Stationary Hospital. This offer met with a favourable reception, and was submitted to the War Office. On 27th September a reply was received accepting the offer with thanks. The C.O. received his appointment on 15th October, and steps were at once taken to organise the Unit. Some delay was caused by the difficulty of securing suitable quarters, but the University generously provided these in the building

formerly occupied by the medical school. A mess room was found next door by arranging with Principal Kaulbach, of the Maritime Business College, for the use of the dining-room and kitchen of the College.

The first man was enlisted on 21st October, and on the 28th a party of men proceeded to transform the old medical school building into barracks and orderly room. These were occupied on 1st November, and the examination, enlistment, and training of recruits went on.

When it became generally known that the Hospital had been accepted, applications for positions in it came rapidly in from all parts of the country. The establishment of a Stationary Hospital requires twelve medical officers and twenty-seven nursing sisters. Thirty medical men and over eighty nurses applied for these positions, and in many cases it was no easy matter to decide on the selection, but, other things being equal, preference was given to medical men on the staff of the University or graduates of the medical school, and to nurses whose training had been in the Victoria General Hospital or St Joseph's Hospital, these being the only general hospitals in Nova Scotia with the number of beds necessary to satisfy the requirements of the service.

On 16th December 1915 the Unit was inspected by General BENSON, G.O.C., Colonel A. H. POWELL, the D.A.A. & Q.M.G., and Colonel GRANT, A.D.M.S., and shortly afterwards orders were received to proceed overseas.

No. 7 Stationary Hospital (Dalhousie) left Halifax on 31st December 1915, and sailed from St John, N.B., on New Year's Day on H.M.T.S. "Metagama," in company with a large number of other troops, under the command of Colonel H. C. BICKFORD, G.S.O.; arrived in Plymouth Monday morning, 10th January, and on the evening of the same day arrived at Shorncliffe.

On 5th February 1916 the Hospital took over the administration of Shorncliffe Military Hospital, and on 18th June embarked for France.

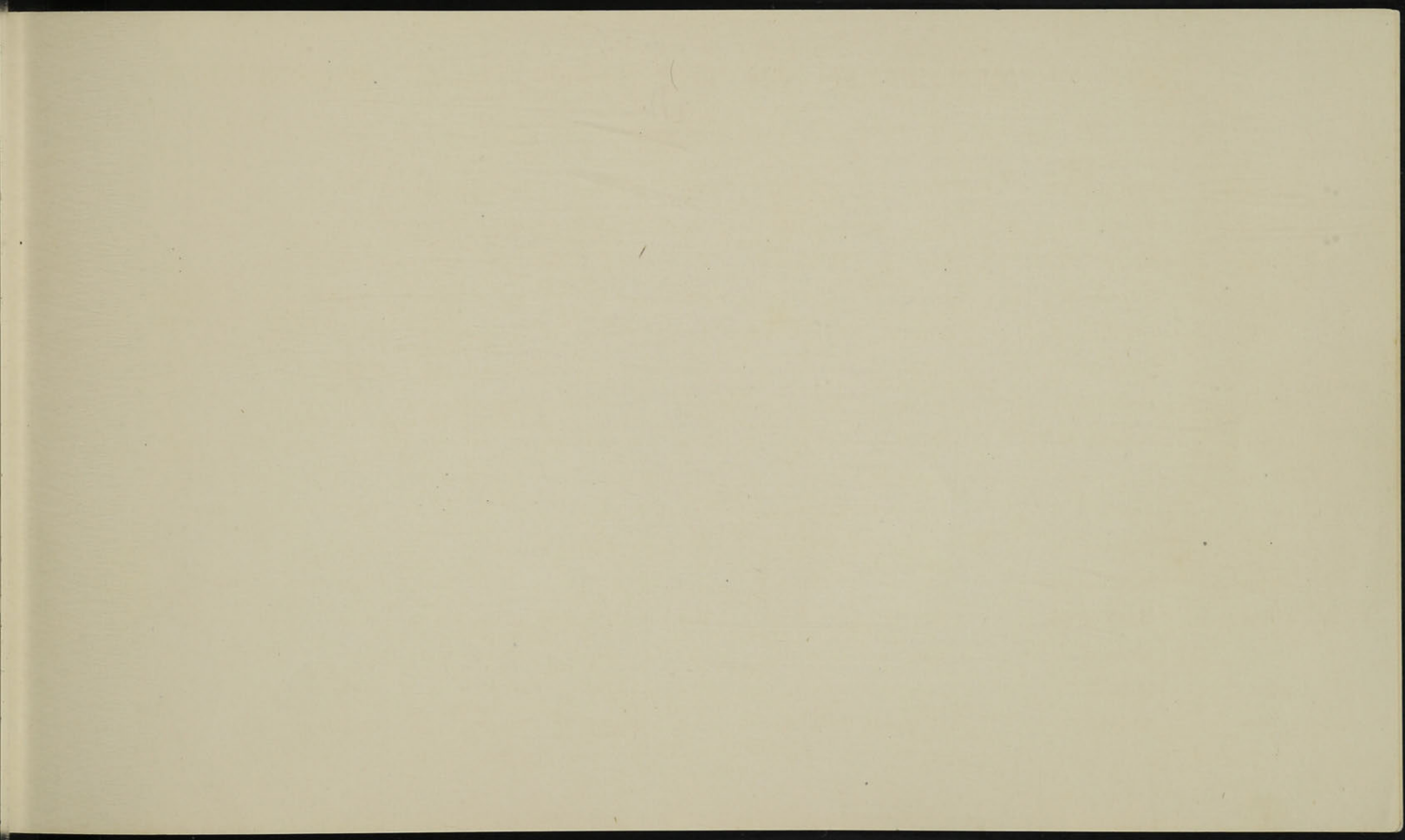

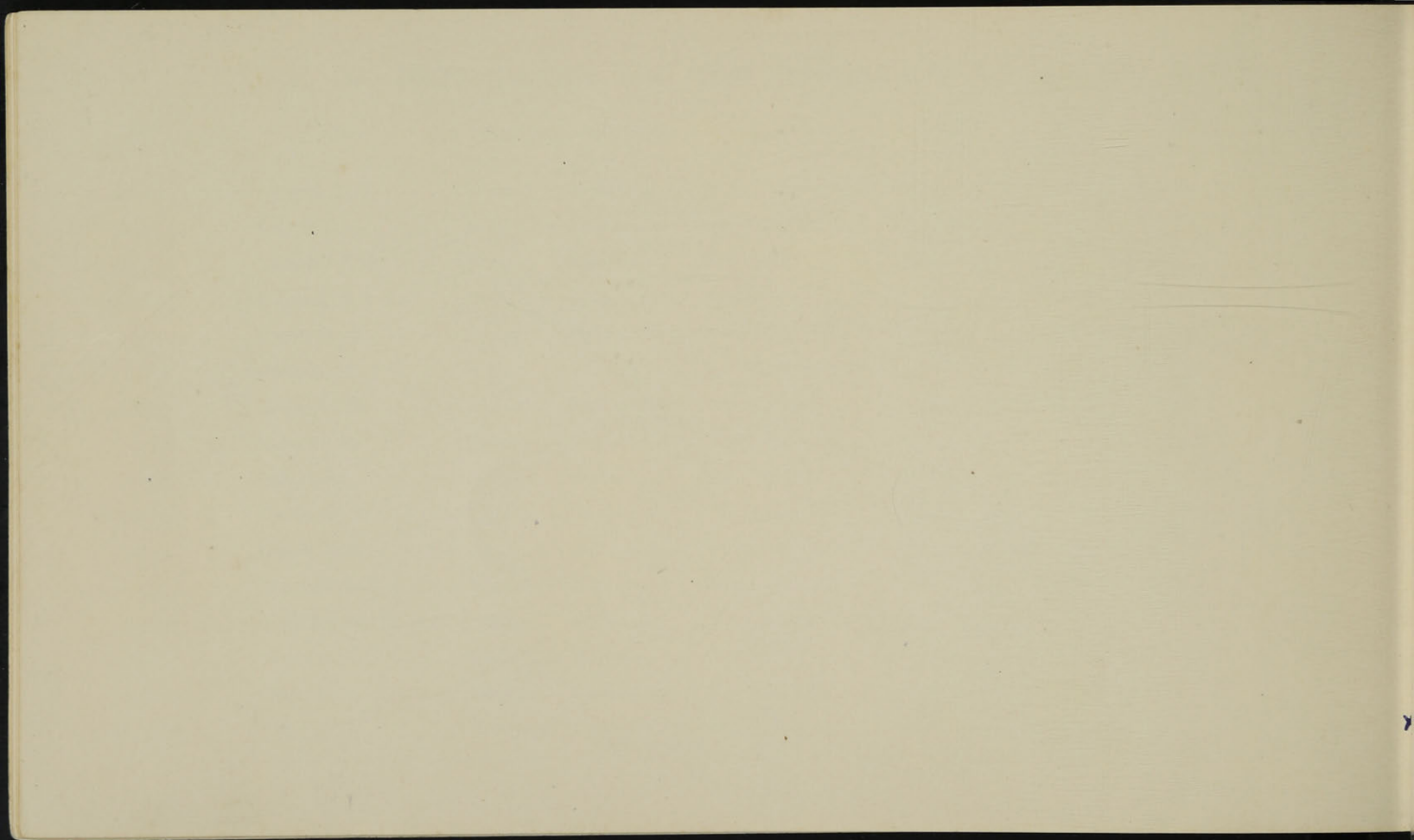
