7547. In Latin, on parchment: written in 1621 at Pisa: $8\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$ in., 6 leaves: with full-page coat of arms and illuminated title-piece: in contemporary binding of morocco tooled in gold, repaired.

Diploma of the University of Pisa, conferring upon Stephanus de Mazzantis of Leghorn, son of Joannes Andreas de Mazzantis, the degree of doctor of canon and civil law, 2 Feb., 1621; subscribed by Joannes Botteghesius, chancellor. On fol. 1^v is the coat of arms of the recipient.

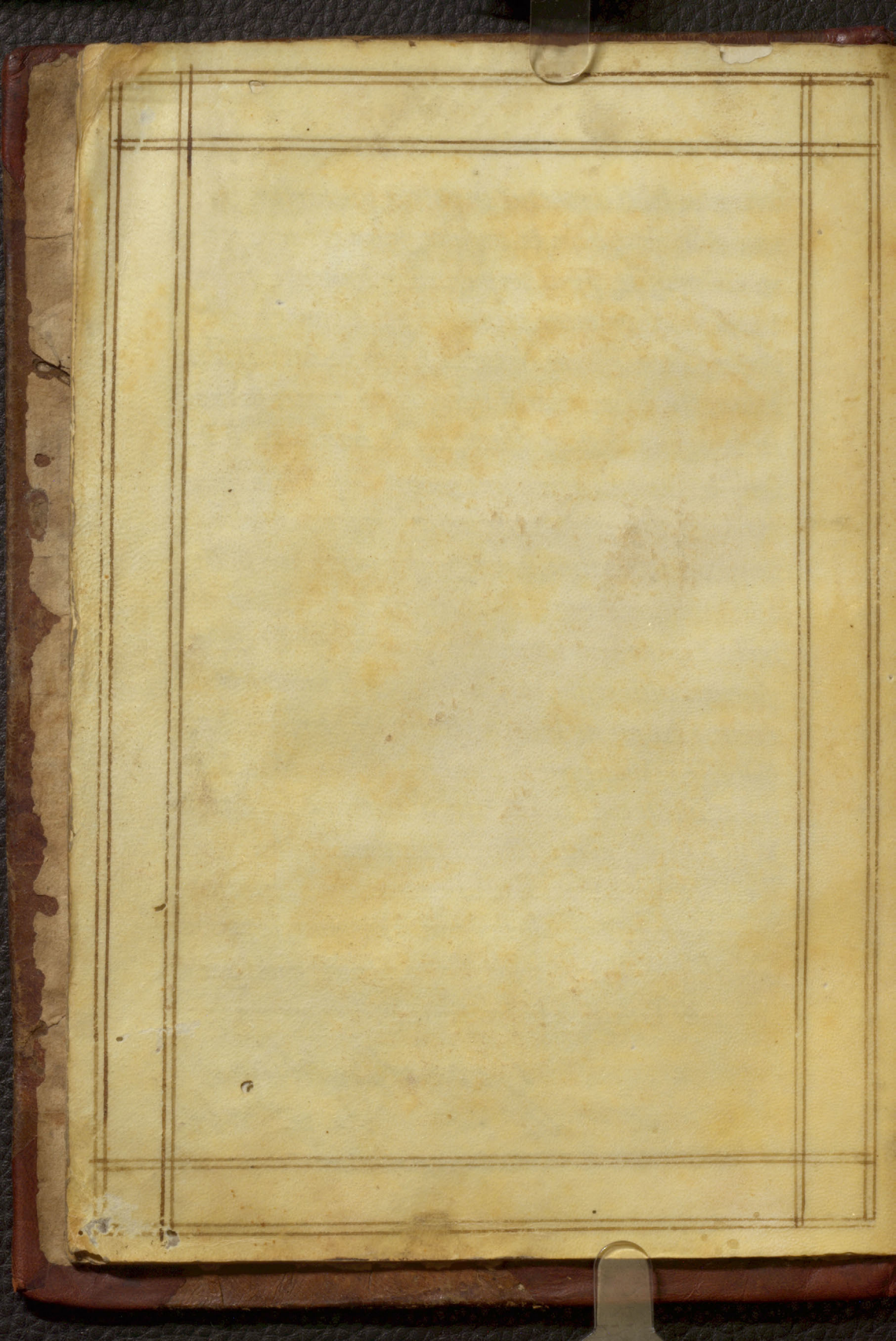

DIPLOMA of Doctor in Canon Law, granted by the University of Pisa to Stephanus de Mazzantis in the year 1621.

Written on six pages of vellum, the first having a coat of arms emblazoned in colours, surrounded by a decorative border. Bound in contemporary morocco, gilt with a semis of flowers, fillets and border. The binding, though somewhat worn, is very interesting & decorative.
