 Mud Island *Base of H.C. 4 miles after that at Stoddart Core & Range about the same as at Seal Island.*

Scale — 1 in. = 10 miles
 B. Bay, C. Cape, H.C. Head of Harbour, L. Land, P. Point, R. River, F. Rock
 etc. etc. ground in sand or rock, a small sh. shell, at some places on the land show the height in feet above the sea.
 Bearings are Magnetic.

- D. To show the ledge of St. John's House open of Bay ledge.
- E. Course through the Narrows.
- F. White Pine on little tree cruce between the Triangle.
- G. Crown white house open of Gunning I. 1/2 mile W. 1/2 mile E.
- H. The Course up starting the Lighthouse rock.
