Pope Head  $44^{\circ} 50' 00''$  N.  $54^{\circ} 47' 00''$  W.  
H.W.F.C. Pope Head  $44^{\circ} 50' 00''$  N. Springs rise 6 1/2, Neaps 4 1/2 feet.  
F. Flood, Rev. Receding Light. - R. Black, Ch. Obsolete, R. Red W. White Buoy.  
Ink broken, A. clay, G. gravel, M. mud, S. rock, S. sand, Sh. shells, St. stone.  
Figures on the land show the height in feet above High Water.  
Roman Figures only the approximate height.  
Magnetic Variation in 1857 increasing approximately 5 annually.
