



**SAILING DIRECTIONS**  
 Approaching from the Southward. Bring Thatcher's L.N.Lt. to bear W. by N. and  
 Straitsmouth Lt. Ho. N. W. by N. this clears the Ledge; when stem N. N. W. & W.  
 passing about two cables length to the Northward, and Eastward of Straitsmouth Ledge;  
 continue on this course until the Little Salvages S.W. by S. when steer W. by S. until the large  
 granite factory in Rockport bears E. S. W. run for it passing midway between the points  
 of the Harbor, when anchor in 11 fathoms or pass between the Buoys to the pier heads.
