but best com^{pl} to Mr Rose —

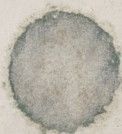

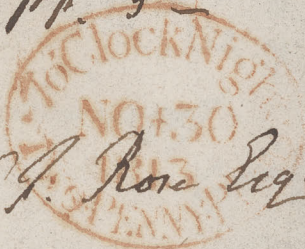
