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PREFACE

The collections catalogued in the pages which follow have long enjoyed a well deserved renown in the art world of Paris. Indeed as far back as 1877 they formed the subject of two articles by M. Charles Guellette which appeared in the "Gazette des Beaux-Arts" of that year under the title "Les Cabinets d'Art à Paris—La Collection de M. Henri de Greffulhe".

It is interesting to recall that in some ways the present collections supply a link with the days when the Wallace Collection was formed. Sir Richard Wallace's great friend and valued adviser was the Comte d'Armaillé, father of the Duchesse de Broglie, a connoisseur whose taste and knowledge were and remain famous; and he was the brother-in-law of the Comte Greffulhe, father of Comte Henri. In those happy days when trouvailles were more easily achieved than now, counsels, suggestions and experiences were freely exchanged mutually in this circle of friends, united by the common bond of love of art; and the Wallace Collection and the Greffulhe Collection thus may be said to have grown simultaneously. It was in this incomparable school of connoisseurship that Comte Henri Greffulhe (1848-1932) ever since the days of his childhood formed his taste and acquired those qualities as a judge of art to which his collections bear such eloquent testimony. A friend of his later years, to whose collaboration the collection in a subsequent stage owed not a little, was that well-known connoisseur, the late M. George Hoentschel.

Displayed in his Paris house in the Rue d'Astorg and his delightful country Château at Bois-Boudran, the collections were for years an object of great admiration to those who were admitted to the privilege of seeing them. Only very occasionally some examples from the collections figured at public exhibitions; as when some French 18th Century Drawings of the highest merit and interest were lent to the memorable exhibition of French 18th Century Art held at the Berlin Academy of Art in 1910.

For the rest, we feel that the descriptions and illustrations which follow may be left to speak for themselves, recording as they do the essential features of a collection where paintings and drawings met in harmony and on an equal footing with tapestries, bronzes and furniture, some pieces of which may be traced back to the possession of the French Royal House and more particularly of Marie Antoinette.
