

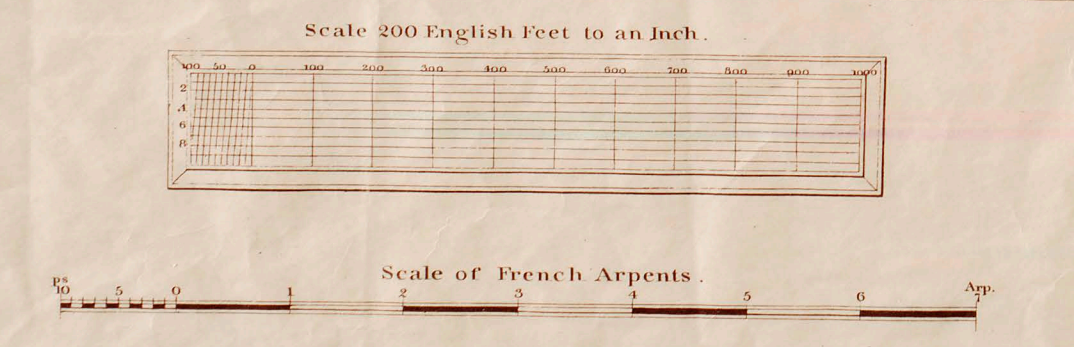

REMARKS.
Public Buildings are designated by a deep
black shade.
Dwelling Houses thus .
Warehouses, Stables, Barns, Sheds and
every description of out Buildings
by this light shade .
The course of the Water Conduits is shown
by a strong dotted line .
Fire Plugs .
The Water Line of the River St. Lawrence is
laid down as it appears when the water is
at about middling height. Vis when the
summit of the small Island at the Port is
from 2 1/2 to 5 feet above the surface.
