Every HEAD OF A FAMILY containing children under 18 years of age can obtain, on condition of settlement, a FREE GRANT OF TWO HUNDRED ACRES of LAND and ONE HUNDRED additional for each Member of his or her family, male or female, over 18 years of age; and ANY PERSON over 18 years of age on condition of settlement, can obtain a FREE GRANT OF ONE HUNDRED ACRES.

The Free Grant Lands at present comprise eighty-nine Townships, each containing from 50 to 60 thousand acres, and are indicated on the map by being shaded with fine black lines. Other Townships will be set apart for Free Grant purposes as fast as they may be required for settlement.

FREE GRANT AGENCIES.

- 1. The Parry Sound Agency—This contains eight townships, McDougall, Foley, Humphrey, Cartwell, Christie, McKellar, Hazeman, and Ferguson. In summer the best route is from Toronto to Collingwood by the Northern Railway, and from Collingwood to Parry Sound by steamer. In winter the route is from Toronto to Barrie by the Northern Railway, and from Barrie to Parry Sound by Stage. Alex. Stephens, M.D., is the Government Agent for these townships; his office is at Parry Sound, in the township of McDougall.

REGISTERS OF THE LABOUR MARKET, and of improved Farms for sale, are kept at the Immigration Agencies in the Province, and at the Quebec Agency, where arrangements are made for directing immigrants to those points where employment can be most readily obtained. Passports must be purchased in accordance with the provisions of Ontario and are issued to apply personally, or by letter, to the Canadian Government Immigration Agents in Europe, viz: Wm. DIXON, 11 Adam Street, Adelphi; London, W. C. G. F. HAIGH, Liverpool; W. EDWARDS, 20 Salisbury Square; London; HENRY J. LARKIN, Eden Quay, Dublin; CHARLES FOY, 11 Clarendon St., Belfast; and ALEX.
