Green I. (highest part) Lat. 47° 53' 43" N. Long. 52° 42' 25" W. of Greenwich.  
H.W.F. & C. VII: 49<sup>m</sup>. Springs rise 34<sup>l</sup>. Neaps 2<sup>l</sup>.  
cl. coral, g. gravel, m. mud, r. rock, s. sand, sh. shells.  
Figures on the land express the heights in feet above the sea.  
Magnetic Variation in 1866, believed to be nearly stationary.  
Bearings are Magnetic.
